1.	Hat x 1
2.	Safari Jacket x 1, heavy jacket and one light jacket.
3.	Safari Shirts x 4
4.	Safari Pants x 3 (Bring at least one pair of long trousers). Jeans, shorts.
5.	Shirts, Polo's,
5.	Clothing for evenings in camp after the days travel maybe after you had taken a shower.
6.	Belt x 1
7.	Underwear x 5
8.	Socks x 5 pairs
9.	Gloves x 1 pair
10.	Pyjamas x 2 (sleeping clothes)
11.	Worn in Safari Boots / Shoes x 2 pairs (One pair of boots and one pair of sneakers will be sufficient)
12.	Sandals or flip flops x 1 (Useful to wear around camp to give your feet a rest)

Toiletries:

12.	Good hospitals and doctors are close; Safari South also have Heliresque, in the unlikely event to be lifted by helicopter to hospital.	



Luggage:

1.	Main baggage.	
2.	Duffle bags are not permitted. Bags not permitted are bags with longs straps or irregular shapes these bags not permitted by South African airports.	
3.	Rucksack / Day pack	
4.	Rooms and accommodation do have lockable safes.	

Documentation:

1.	Passport and copies of Passport	
2.	Emergency Phone Numbers	
3.	Insurance Card / Medevac Insurance details (if applicable)

7.	Credit Cards. Safari South do have a credit card machine/facility.
